**Toma treinta hombres contigo y saca del pozo a Jeremías, antes de que muera.**

Nuestra invocación se hace intensa cuando nos sentimos presa de la injusticia y de la maldad, pero Dios no está lejos. La misión del profeta no es agradecer a los hombres, sino proclamar lo de Dios. Es por eso que Dios no puede abandonar a su siervo. El cristiano, sacerdote, profeta y rey por don bautismal, está llamado a realizar su misión de luz y de sal en la historia de los hombres. Si el juicio de los hombres es de condena, el de Dios, es juicio de salvación.

**No se cansen ni pierdan el ánimo, porque todavía no han llegado a derramar su sangre en la lucha contra el pecado.**

Si la meta es ser como el Maestro, él llegó hasta derramar su sangre por nosotros. La realización de nuestra vocación está en la pascua que no puede ser solo participada, sino asumida y vivida en carne propia. Derramar la sangre es como ser parte activa de la celebración eucarística, memorial de la pascua de Cristo y misterio de amor.
