**ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME
JUNE 17, 2007**

"Two people were in debt to a certain creditor; one owed five hundred days' wages, the other owed fifty. Since they were unable to repay the debt, he forgave it for both. Which of them will love him more?" Simon said in reply, 'The one, I suppose, whose larger debt was forgiven.' He said to him, 'You have judged rightly' ... 'yet I live, no longer I, but Christ lives in me ... I live by faith in the Son of God who has loved me and given Himself up for me. I do not nullify the grace of God.'"

Pause for a minute and try to remember how many notices and application forms you have received for credit cards and debt consolidation in the past few months. It seems every institution is looking to provide the solution for our economic needs. Year after year we increase the legal limit of a national debt. So much rides on a two-inch piece of plastic.

The conversation of Jesus with Simon uses the example of credit and the cancellation of two debts. Surely the person who has been so generously forgiven is the one who will respond with greater love. Even if I think my debt is less, I still want to respond and seek that forgiveness.

Because debt payments can be extended for many years, as a mortgage or long term lease, I might not appreciate what Jesus did for me once and for all. He forgave me by giving His life for me. He wanted to share His life with me, so that with Paul I can say that "Christ lives in me."

I speak about my love for God, but I can probably love Him more. I express my love for God through my concern and response to others. As I do, may they see that Christ does live in me.

Remembering the old translation of the Lord's prayer, we say "forgive us our debts as we forgive our debtors." The sabbatical year of 2000 found some countries forgiving the debt of impoverished nations. Would that we live in that spirit as a country and as individuals.

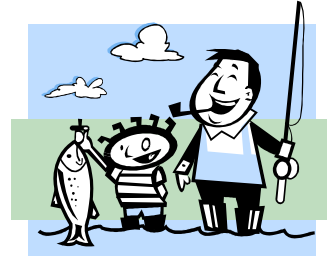
