### **HOLY TRINITY SUNDAY**

**JUNE 3, 2007**

"Since we have been justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ ... we boast in hope of the glory of God ... Not only that, but we even boast of our afflictions, knowing that affliction produces endurance, and endurance, proven character, and proven character, hope, and hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured into our hearts through the Holy Spirit who has been given to us."

In many of Saint Paul's writings we find litanies or progressive steps, leading us to examine the growth of God's grace in our lives. Sometimes he stresses faults and then contrasts them with the opposite virtue. Today, he begins with the peace we have with God, through the presence of Jesus Christ. After stating the fact, he traces what God has done for us through the gift of the Spirit. He speaks implicitly of the Three Persons on this special feast.

Reviewing the steps Paul describes, we know of the many afflictions, tests and trials which confront us. Because of grace we are empowered to struggle so that they do not overwhelm us, but are met head on. Aware of His presence with us in the "fight", "battle", "struggle" (different saints used different descriptive words), we are filled with hope. The love of God, His grace or His life, has not just been offered, but "poured" into our hearts. When Paul spoke to the Philippians he told them that Christ "emptied" Himself. Today, He pours His love on us through the Holy Spirit.

How ready am I to accept this gift? Do I have a raincoat or poncho to repel the gift He offers me?
