**You Can Avoid a Stroke!
LifeLine Screening**

At St. John's lower hall, Nov. 6, 9:00 - 4:15. Screenings are fast, painless and offered at low cost. They involve the use of ultrasound technology. They scan for potential health problems related to: blocked arteries which can lead to stroke, aortic aneurysms which can lead to rupture, and plaque buildup in the arteries in the legs which is a strong predictor of heart disease. Also offered is a bone density screening to assess risk for osteoporosis.

Each screening takes about ten minutes. Cost of the three heart related screenings is \$119. Add the bone density screening for only \$10, for a total of \$129. Pre-registration is required. Sign up by calling 1-800-407-4557.
