LECTURAS PARA EL DIA DE HOY:

1 Lectura: 1Re 19,9a.11-3a: Aguarda al Señor que pasa.

2 Lectura: Rm 9,1-5: Digo la verdad en Cristo

Evangelió: Mt 14,22-33: ¡Hombre de poca fe! ¿Por qué dudaste?

Empezó a hundirse y gritó: "Señor, sálvame"

Hoy, la experiencia de Pedro refleja situaciones que hemos experimentado también nosotros más de una vez. ¿Quién no ha visto *hacer aguas* sus proyectos y no ha experimentado la tentación del desánimo o de la desesperación? En circunstancias así, debemos reavivar la fe y decir con el salmista: «Muéstranos, Señor, tu misericordia y danos tu salvación». Para la mentalidad antigua, el mar era el lugar donde habitaban las fuerzas del mal, el reino de la muerte, amenazador para el hombre. Al "andar sobre el agua", Jesús nos indica que con su muerte y resurrección triunfa sobre el poder del mal y de la muerte, que nos amenaza y busca destrozarnos. Nuestra existencia, ¿no es también como una frágil embarcación, sacudida por las olas, que atraviesa el mar de la vida y que espera llegar a una meta que tenga sentido?

Pedro creía tener una fe clara y una fuerza muy consistente, pero «empezó a hundirse»; Pedro había asegurado a Jesús que estaba dispuesto a seguirlo hasta morir, pero su debilidad lo acobardó y negó al Maestro en los hechos de la Pasión. ¿Por qué Pedro se hunde justo cuando empieza a andar sobre el agua? Porque, en vez de mirar a Jesucristo, miró al mar y eso le hizo perder fuerza y, a partir de ese instante, su confianza en el Señor se debilitó y los pies no le respondieron. Pero, Jesús le extendió la mano, lo agarró y lo salvó. Después de su resurrección, el Señor no permite que su apóstol se hunda en el remordimiento y la desesperación y le devuelve la confianza con su perdón generoso.

ORACION: Dios, Padre nuestro, acrecienta en nosotros el sentimiento de hijos tuyos, nuestro amor y nuestra confianza en Ti, para que seamos en todo momento y circunstancia signos vivos de tu presencia en medio de la humanidad. Por Jesucristo Nuestro Señor. AMEN.
