Él, que ha creado el cielo y la tierra de la nada, hubiese podido de igual forma haber fácilmente creado un gran banquete para saciar a aquella multitud. Pero prefirió hacer el milagro partiendo de lo único que sus discípulos podían entregarle. «Si aquí no tenemos más que cinco panes y dos peces», le dijeron. «Traédmelos», les respondió Jesús. Y el Señor llevó a cabo la multiplicación de tan exiguo recurso ni tan sólo suficiente para alimentar a una familia normal para dar de comer a unas 5000 familias.

El Señor procedió de igual forma en el festín de las bodas de Caná. Él, que creó todos los mares, podía fácilmente haber llenado con el vino más selecto aquellas tinajas de más de 100 litros, partiendo de cero.
