Evangeliomt 11,25-30: Carguen con mi yugo y aprendan de mí



«Venid a mí todos los que estáis fatigados y sobrecargados, y yo os daré descanso»

Hoy, Jesús nos muestra dos realidades que le definen: que Él es quien conoce al Padre con toda la profundidad y que Él es «manso y humilde de corazón». También podemos descubrir ahí dos actitudes necesarias para poder entender y vivir lo que Jesús nos ofrece: la sencillez y el deseo de acercarnos a Él.

A los sabios y entendidos frecuentemente les es difícil entrar en el misterio del Reino, porque no están abiertos a la novedad de la revelación divina; Dios no deja de manifestarse, pero ellos creen que ya lo saben todo y, por tanto, Dios ya no les puede sorprender. Los sencillos, en cambio, como los niños en sus mejores momentos, son receptivos, son como una esponja que absorbe el agua, tienen capacidad de sorpresa y de admiración. También hay excepciones, e incluso, hay expertos en ciencias humanas que pueden ser humildes por lo que al conocimiento de Dios se refiere. En el Padre, Jesús encuentra su reposo, y su paz puede ser refugio para todos aquellos que han sido maleados por la vida: «Venid a mí todos los que estáis fatigados y sobrecargados, y yo os daré descanso».

Jesús es humilde, y la humildad es hermana de la sencillez. Cuando aprendamos a ser felices a través de la sencillez, entonces muchas complicaciones se deshacen, muchas necesidades desaparecen, y al fin podemos reposar. Jesús nos invita a seguirlo; no nos engaña: estar con Él es llevar su yugo, asumir la exigencia del amor. No se nos ahorrará el sufrimiento, pero su carga es ligera, porque nuestro sufrimiento no nos vendrá a causa de nuestro egoísmo, sino que sufriremos sólo lo que nos sea necesario y basta, por amor y con la ayuda del Espíritu. Además, no olvidemos, «las tribulaciones que se sufren por Dios quedan suavizadas por la esperanza»
