Stages of Marriage

Experts tell us that marriages typically move through three stages of evolution.

The Honeymoon Here, life is more or less blissful, and for the most part, each partner is blind to the other's faults – as well as their own.

Disillusionment This stage is characterized by surprise, bewilderment, and frustration, i.e. "Why didn't I notice....when we were dating? How come (s)he never says or does.....anymore? When will (s)he change? Etc. For many couples, this stage – and how they choose to respond to it-- may determine what becomes of their marriage. Couples that decide to work together, communicate with one another in healthy ways and seek help when necessary – will likely have a much different outcome than those who have decided that "its over."

Real Maturity Here, couples possess a healthy awareness (of their spouse – and themselves) that both of them have flaws, and that they must daily choose to love one another despite those flaws. Obviously, there are significant differences between ordinary flaws and a serious problem. Mature couples know that it's time to help to get help, and aren't too ashamed or proud to do so.

Evangelio: Mt 9,36-10,8: Llamó y envió a los discípulos



Hoy, el Evangelio nos dice que el Señor viendo al pueblo se sentía turbado, porque aquel pueblo iba desorientado y cansado, como ovejas sin pastor. El pueblo de Israel sabía muy bien, mejor que nosotros, hombres de ciudad; qué era un pastor, y el alboroto que se formaba cuando las ovejas se encontraban solas sin pastor. Si Jesús viniera hoy, yo creo que repetiría las mismas palabras: pues hay muchas personas desorientadas, buscando cuál es el sentido de la vida. Señor, ¿qué solución das a este gran problema? Pues Jesús pide oración, escoge a doce apóstoles y los envía a predicar el reino de Dios.

¡Escogió a doce Apóstoles! Envía a estos doce hombres a predicar: «El Reino de los Cielos está cerca'. Curad enfermos, resucitad muertos, purificad leprosos, expulsad demonios. Gratis lo recibisteis; dadlo gratis» (Lo que los Apóstoles hicieron, y nosotros hemos de hacer, es predicar a la persona adorable de Jesucristo y su mensaje de paz y de amor, y eso de una manera desinteresada.

Todos estamos convocados a ello: los sucesores de los Apóstoles, los obispos y los otros pastores; pero también, en unión con ellos, todos los fieles. Todos tenemos esta

misión en el mundo: sanar a la humanidad de sus heridas, orientarla en sus búsquedas. No solamente los obispos y los sacerdotes, sino también los laicos: por ejemplo, en la familia en su carácter de hogar y escuela de fe; en la universidad y en los colegios; en los medios de comunicación; en el mundo sanitario, y cada cristiano en su ambiente de amistad y de trabajo.

Escuchemos a san Francisco de Sales, que escribe: «En la misma creación de las cosas, Dios, el Creador, mandó a las plantas que cada una diera el fruto según la especie. Igualmente, los cristianos que son plantas vivas de la Iglesia les mandó a cada uno de ellos que diera fruto de devoción según la calidad, el estado y la vocación que tuviera».

ORACION : Señor, te pedimos que transformes nuestra vida, de manera que desaparezca de nuestro corazón toda duda, todo temor y toda vacilación, y que así podamos ser instrumentos de tu amor, de modo que las personas y las sociedades vivan llenas de esperanza, de justicia y de paz.
