LECTURAS PARA EL DIA DE HOY:

1 Lectura: Jb 19,1.23-27a: Yo sé que está vivo mi Redentor

2 Lectura: Flp 3,20-21: Nuestra patria está en los cielos

Evangelio: Mc 15,33-39;16,1-6: Jesús, lanzando un grito, expiró

«El que se ensalce, será humillado; y el que se humille, será ensalzado»

Hoy, el Señor nos hace un retrato de los notables de Israel (fariseos, maestros de la Ley...). Éstos viven en una situación superficial, no son más que apariencias: «Todas sus obras las hacen para ser vistos por los hombres» Y, además, cayendo en la incoherencia, «porque dicen y no hacen», se hacen esclavos de su propio engaño al buscar sólo la aprobación o la admiración de los hombres. De esto depende su consistencia. Por sí mismos no son más que patética vanidad, orgullo absurdo, vaciedad y necesidad.

Desde los inicios de la humanidad continúa siendo la tentación más frecuente; la antigua serpiente continúa susurrándonos al oído: «El día en que comiereis de él [el fruto del árbol que está en medio del jardín], se os abrirán los ojos y seréis como dioses, conocedores del bien y del mal». Y continuamos cayendo en ello, nos hacemos llamar: "rabí", "padre" y "guías"... y tantos otros ampulosos calificativos. Demasiadas veces queremos ocupar el lugar que no nos corresponde. Es la actitud farisaica. Los discípulos de Jesús no han de ser así, más bien al contrario: «El mayor entre vosotros será vuestro servidor». Y como que tenemos un único Padre, todos ellos son hermanos. Como siempre, el Evangelio nos deja claro que no podemos desvincular la dimensión vertical (Padre) y la horizontal (nuestro) o, como se explicaba el domingo pasado,

«amarás al Señor, tu Dios. Amarás a tu prójimo como a ti mismo».

Toda la liturgia de la Palabra de este domingo está impregnada por la ternura y la exigencia de la filiación y de la fraternidad. Fácilmente resuenan en nuestro corazón aquellas palabras de san Juan: «Si alguno dice: 'Amo a Dios', y aborrece a su hermano, es un mentiroso». La nueva evangelización cada vez más urgente nos pide fidelidad, confianza y sinceridad con la vocación que hemos recibido en el bautismo. Si lo hacemos se nos iluminará «el camino de la vida: hartura de goces, delante de tu rostro, a tu derecha, delicias para siempre».
