Tuesday evening, August 4

August 4 is the feast of St. John Vianney, the Cure of Ars, who is the patron saint of priests. Pope Benedict declared this year the Year of the Priest. We will begin our year of celebration and prayer with this special Mass on August 4 at 7:00 pm at St. John's. We will offer the Mass for all of the outstanding men who have served the parishes of St. Joachim and St. John the Evangelist. Please plan to join us for this special Mass.

We will continue to celebrate the Year of the Priest by having a Holy Hour on Monday evenings from 7 to 8 pm.
