Our Parish Cemetery

Thanks to all of you who are following the revised rules regarding flowers, etc. placed at your loved ones graves. The Cemetery Board hopes the cemetery will be maintained as a peaceful place of rest and respect for all those buried there. As a reminder, artificial flowers, balloons, and glass containers are not permitted for safety reasons. Nor are arrangements/pots containing styrofoam.

Flags are permitted from Memorial Day through Independence Day and again on Veteran's Day. All remaining flags were removed on July 11. Following these rules regarding flags helps decrease litter and the associated disrespect to the torn/damaged flags.

Improvements: some work has been done to improve the upper left gravel road and to begin to make improvements in water drainage.

As we reported previously, Senior Girl Scout Carly Giavatto's Gold Award project resulted in the painting of the main flag pole and the addition of the capability of flying the flags of the individual branches of the military. The flag pole at the old cemetery was painted by volunteers and a new flag now flies there.

Two teenagers are in the process of cleaning the grass from the tops of the footstone military markers in the new cemetery.

The headstones that were vandalized in the old cemetery have been set upright again.

Evangelio: Mc 6,30-34: "Eran como ovejas sin pastor"

«Venid también vosotros aparte, a un lugar solitario, para descansar un poco»



Hoy, el Evangelio nos invita a descubrir la importancia de descansar en el Señor. Los Apóstoles regresaban de la misión que Jesús les había dado. Habían expulsado demonios, curado enfermos y predicado el Evangelio. Estaban cansados y Jesús les dice «venid también vosotros aparte, a un lugar solitario, para descansar un poco»

Una de las tentaciones a las que puede sucumbir cualquier cristiano es la de querer hacer muchas cosas descuidando el trato con el Señor. El *Catecismo* recuerda que, a la hora de hacer oración, uno de los peligros más grandes es pensar que hay otras cosas más urgentes y, de esa forma, se acaba descuidando el trato con Dios. Por eso, Jesús, a sus Apóstoles, que han trabajado mucho, que están agotados y eufóricos porque todo les ha ido bien, les dice que tienen que descansar. Y, señala el Evangelio «se fueron en la barca, aparte, a un lugar solitario». Para poder rezar bien se necesitan, al menos dos cosas: la

primera es estar con Jesús, porque es la persona con la que vamos a hablar. Asegurarnos de que estamos con Él. Por eso todo rato de oración empieza, generalmente, y es lo más difícil, con un acto de presencia de Dios. Tomar conciencia de que estamos con Él. Y la segunda es la necesaria soledad. Si queremos hablar con alguien, tener una conversación íntima y profunda, escogemos la soledad.
