Hoy, podemos contemplar cómo se forja en nuestro interior tanto el amor humano como el amor sobrenatural, ya que tenemos un mismo corazón para amar a Dios y a los otros. Generalmente, el amor va abriéndose paso en el corazón humano cuando se descubre el atractivo del otro: su simpatía, su bondad. A continuación, el enamoramiento, fruto de sentirse correspondido. Dice que «mucha gente le seguía porque veían las señales que realizaba en los enfermos». Jesús les escuchaba, les hacía caso, porque sabía lo que necesitaban.

Jesucristo siente un poderoso atractivo por mí y quiere mi realización humana y sobrenatural. Me ama tal como soy, con mis miserias, porque pido perdón y, con su ayuda, sigo esforzándome. «Dándose cuenta Jesús de que intentaban venir a tomarle por la fuerza para hacerle rey, huyó de nuevo al monte Éi solo». Les diré al día siguiente: «En verdad, en verdad os digo: vosotros me buscáis, no porque habéis visto señales, sino porque habéis comido de los panes y os habéis saciado». Escribe san Agustín: «¡Cuántos hay que buscan a Jesús, guiados solamente por

intereses temporales! Apenas se busca a Jesús por Jesús».
