Hoy, es el dia mas grande para el corazon de un cristiano, por que la iglesia despues de festejar el jueves santo la institucion de la eucaristia, busca ahora la exaltacion de este augusto sacramento, tratando de que todos lo adoremos ilimitadamente. Todo lo que podemos hacer es poco para intentar corresponder a una entrega tan humilde, tan escondida, tan impresionante. El creador de cielos y tierra se esconde en las especies sacramentales y se nos ofrece como alimento de nuestras almas. Es el pan de los angeles y el alimento de los que estamos en camino.
