**LECTURAS PARA EL DIA DE HOY:**

**1 Lectura: 2Sm 12, 7-10. 13:** El Señor ha perdonado ya tu pecado, no morirás

**2 Lectura: Gal 2, 16. 19-21:** Vivo yo, pero no soy yo, es Cristo quien vive en mí.

**Evangelio: Lc 7, 36-8, 3:** Tus pecados te son perdonados

**“No me diste agua para los pies, no me diste el beso no ungiste mi cabeza con aceite”**

Hoy, el Evangelio nos explica aquel que encuentra a Jesús no puede hacerlo con indiferencia. ¿Por qué el rabino lo invita a compartir su comida para tratarlo luego con descortesía descuidando atenderlo con las muestras de respeto y honor acostumbradas?

Lucas dibuja un agudo contraste entre el arrogante e incorrupto fariseo, que sigue todas las normas pero carece de la sensibilidad de aplicar las más elementales acciones de amabilidad hacia un huésped, y la mujer que teniendo una reputación de pecadora recibe, en cambio, a Jesús con una atención amorosa. No hay duda que ella entiende la importancia de esa amorosa atención al tiempo que el fariseo carece totalmente de esa sensibilidad. Los Fariseos evitaban la compañía de los "pecadores públicos" y, al hacerlo, descuidaban darles la ayuda que necesitaban para que encontrasen su curación y su integridad.

Como humanos, es muy difícil amar de verdad y saber perdonar a las personas, y caemos en la tentación de preocuparnos de las apariencias para adquirir así la reputación de una vida virtuosa mientras continuamos cultivando nuestra tendencia a juzgar y a no perdonar. Muchas de las narraciones del Evangelio nos hablan de la actitud de los fariseos frente a los publicanos. Si ahora quisiésemos describir lo que los Fariseos harían si viviesen en nuestra sociedad actual, podríamos ver, por ejemplo, que ciertamente irían a Misa y la seguirían debidamente

pero, en su camino de vuelta a casa, no dudarían en criticar negativamente a los demás. Desde luego es

laudable asistir a Misa y observar las normas de la conducta cristiana, pero toda esa cuidadosa observancia carece de valor si no va acompañada de un genuino espíritu de amor y perdón.

Según Benedicto XVI, «el nuevo culto cristiano abarca todos los aspectos de la vida, transfigurándola. La Eucaristía, al implicar la realidad humana concreta del creyente, hace posible día a día la transfiguración progresiva del hombre, llamado a ser por gracia imagen del Hijo de Dios»

*Oración: Misterio infinito, a quien creemos presente en el proceso de la vida y en la historia del cosmo, Haz que seamos capaces de comprender que la fuerza que todo lo sostiene es el Amor, y que nosotros mismos sólo alcanzaremos la felicidad en el Amor. Nosotros te lo pedimos apoyados en el ejemplo de Jesús, unidos a todos los hombres y mujeres que te buscan por los muchos caminos. Amén.*
