12 Domingo del tiempo ordinario**LECTURAS PARA EL DIA DE HOY:**

1 Lectura: Zac 12, 10-11; 13, 1: Mirarán al que atravesaron

2 Lectura: Gal 3, 26-29: Los que habéis sido bautizados os habéis revestido de Cristo

Evangelio: Lc 9, 18-24: Tú eres el Mesías de Dios.

Y vosotros, ¿quién decís que soy yo?

Hoy, en el Evangelio, Jesús nos sitúa ante una pregunta clave, fundamental. De su respuesta depende nuestra vida: «Y vosotros, ¿quién decís que soy yo?» Pedro responde en nombre de todos: «El Cristo de Dios». ¿Cuál es nuestra respuesta? ¿Conocemos suficientemente a Jesús como para poder responder? La oración, la lectura del Evangelio, la vida sacramental y la Iglesia son fuentes inseparables que nos llevan a conocerle y a “vivirlo”. Hasta que no seamos capaces de responder con Pedro con todo el corazón y con la misma sencillez, seguramente todavía no nos habremos dejado transformar por Él. Hemos de conseguir sentir como Pedro, ¡hemos de lograr sentir como la Iglesia para poder responder de manera satisfactoria a la pregunta de Jesús!

Pero el Evangelio de hoy acaba con una exhortación a seguir al Señor desde la humildad, desde la negación y la cruz. Seguir a Jesús de esta manera sólo puede dar salvación, libertad. «Lo que sucede con el oro puro, también sucede con la Iglesia; esto es, que cuando pasa por el fuego, no experimenta ningún mal; más bien lo contrario, su esplendor aumenta». Ni la contrariedad, ni la persecución por causa del Reino, nos han de dar miedo, más bien nos han de ser motivo de esperanza e, incluso,

de alegría. Dar la vida por Cristo no es perderla, es ganarla para toda la eternidad. Jesús nos pide que nos humillemos

totalmente por fidelidad al Evangelio, quiere que, libremente, le demos toda nuestra existencia. ¡Vale la pena dar la vida por el Reino!

Seguir, imitar, vivir la vida de la gracia, en definitiva, permanecer en Dios es el objetivo de nuestra vida cristiana: «Dios se hizo hombre para que imitando el ejemplo de un hombre, cosa posible, lleguemos a Dios, cosa que antes era imposible» (San Agustín). ¡Que Dios, con la fuerza del su Espíritu Santo, nos ayude a ello!

***Oración:** Dios, Padre misericordioso, que quisiste preparar los caminos de tu Hijo con el envío de Juan Bautista como su “precursor”; haznos a todos nosotros “precursores” de tu Hijo, para que allanemos los caminos y eliminemos los obstáculos al crecimiento del Amor y de la Unidad, por Jesucristo Nuestro Señor. Amen.*
