La Santísima Trinidad

LECTURAS PARA EL DIA DE HOY:

1 Lectura: Prov 8, 22-31: Antes de comenzar la tierra, la sabiduría fue engendrada.

2 Lectura: Rom 5, 1-5: A Dios, por medio de Cristo, en el amor derramado con el Espíritu.

Evangelio: Jn 16, 16-15: Cuando venga el, el espíritu de la verdad, os llevara a la verdad completa.

"Cuando venga el espíritu de la verdad os guiara hasta la verdad completa"

Hoy, celebramos la solemnidad del misterio que está en el centro de nuestra fe, del cual todo procede y al cual todo vuelve. El misterio de la unidad de Dios y, a la vez, de su subsistencia en tres Personas iguales y distintas. Padre, Hijo y Espíritu Santo: la unidad en la comunión y la comunión en la unidad. Conviene que los cristianos, en este gran día, seamos conscientes de que este misterio está presente en nuestras vidas: desde el Bautismo, que recibimos en nombre de la Santísima Trinidad, hasta nuestra participación en la Eucaristía, que se hace para gloria del Padre, por su Hijo Jesucristo, gracias al Espíritu Santo. Y es la señal por la cual nos reconocemos como cristianos: la señal de la Cruz en nombre del Padre, del Hijo y del Espíritu Santo.

La misión del Hijo, Jesucristo, consiste en la revelación de su Padre, del cual es la imagen perfecta, y en el don del Espíritu, también revelado por el Hijo. La lectura evangélica proclamada hoy nos lo muestra: el Hijo recibe todo del Padre en la perfecta unidad: «Todo lo que tiene el Padre es mío», y el Espíritu recibe lo que Él es, del Padre y del Hijo. «Por eso he dicho, dice Jesús, ‘recibirá de lo mío y os lo anunciará a vosotros’». Y en otro pasaje de este

mismo discurso: «Cuando venga el Paráclito, que yo os enviaré de junto al Padre, el Espíritu de la verdad, que procede del Padre, Él dará testimonio de mí».

Aprendamos de esto la gran y consoladora verdad: la Trinidad Santísima, lejos de ponerse aparte, distante e

inaccesible, viene a nosotros, habita en nosotros y nos transforma en interlocutores suyos. Y esto por medio del Espíritu, quien así nos guía hasta la verdad completa. La incomparable “dignidad del cristiano”, de la cual habla varias veces san León el Grande, es ésta: poseer en sí el misterio de Dios y, entonces, tener ya, desde esta tierra, la propia “ciudadanía” en el cielo, es decir, en el seno de la Trinidad Santísima.

ORACION: Señor Dios Eterno, Único y Verdadero, misterio infinito de amor y de vida, Trinidad Santísima, haz de la humanidad creada a tu imagen una sola familia, y que la comunidad eclesial, redimida por la sangre de tu Hijo y renovada por el Espíritu, sea siempre un vivo reflejo de tu misterio comunitario de amor, signo de liberación para los pobres y los últimos de la tierra, y fermento de unidad y de paz para todo el género humano. Por nuestro Señor Jesucristo. AMEN.
